Leadership

- Led transformation of Davidson's 20 year-old Administrative Advisory Group to become a Staff Council in 2017. As Chair of the organization, engaged administrators and other stakeholders across campus in order to successfully pass new bylaws and include hourly staff in the membership of the organization.
- Lead Green Dot Engagement Committee. As Chair, head committee of launch team members to identify hundreds of influential faculty, staff, and students across campus and coordinate bystander training sessions for them.
- Founded Our Library Our Conference, an annual in-house conference for the library staff. Chair of planning committee 2016-present.
- Serve as Vice-President and President-Elect of the Davidson College Chapter of Phi Beta Kappa (Gamma of North Carolina). The second staff member (non-faculty) to serve in this role in the chapter's 95-year history. Selected to represent the chapter as Chapter Delegate to the 45th Phi Beta Kappa Triennial Council in 2018.

Onboarding and Mentoring

- Direct onboarding initiatives for new library staff. Research onboarding practices, coordinate with supervisors, arrange mentor-mentee pairing, and organize monthly team-building meetings for cohort of new staff.
- Serve as Holistic Pre-Major Adviser for 10 students each year. Advise on class selections, connect students with campus resources, and support students in their educational, professional, and personal goals.
- Directed the Peer Research Advisor program from 2012-2016, including hiring, training, and assessing a cohort of students each semester.

Teaching and Reference

- Co-design and co-lead a digital information literacy course for 500+ incoming first-year students each year.
- Provide in-person and virtual reference services to thousands of students, faculty, and staff. Engaged in over 200 one-on-one, in-depth research consultations in the 2017-2018 academic year in addition to responding to other types of research-related inquiries.
- Teach information literacy sessions across all disciplines and class levels. Taught over 50 sessions in the 2017-2018 academic year.

- Create instructional, promotional, and training resources, including digital tutorials and guides.

Outreach and Collections
